The Club raises around £11,000 a year through its various activities including, Christmas street collections with Father Christmas and his sleigh and other fund gathering initiatives.

Much of the cash is distributed within the local community, to charities, groups and individuals seeking financial support for a broad range of causes.

The route to securing the support of the Rotary Club of Middleton starts with the completion of a short, simple application form which should to be submitted by 1st November 2013. The shortlisted bidders will be invited to make a brief presentation to club members during December.

Cheques will be presented to successful applicants at their activity centre providing a photo opportunity and some well-deserved publicity.
