

Step 1

Register for free with PTL. Take down the enquiry details ie: name, address, email, mobile, current licence status and the training they require – C & C+E etc. Ask them do they require online theory training and booking of theory test.

Step 2

Ask the enquiry if they would like us to send a Starter pack containing all forms, application, online training software and provisional course dates as well as booking their driver medical with Ryminster Medical Services – on account as Pennine CPC Training Limited.

Step 3

Attend your Driver Medical and send your completed D4 (medical examination report) and D2 (application for provisional lorry entitlement) to DVLA (envelope in starter pack needs 1st class stamp).

You can then move on to practical skills training.

Pass those two tests and you will have both your licence and your initial CPC qualification card. You will be able to start looking for work right away.
